Remote Learning will enable:

- Students to access their learning tasks
- Students to do and submit their learning tasks
- Students to see feedback on their tasks
- To progress student learning

The three platforms teachers are expected to use for remote learning are:

1. DayMap
2. Learnlink (Office 365)
3. Clickview

Some teachers are already using a range of other online learning platforms with their classes which they will continue to use.
